Upcoming Projects

As the summer approaches, our Trustees have been working hard planning for this year's projects. The Fellowship Hall and the former Jr. High Youth Room, soon to be the new classroom for our growing Day School were painted in early May. Other maintenance and repair needs continue to be addressed as they arise.

The big project this summer will be replacing the heating and cooling units for the Fellowship Hall. They are the ones outside of the south entrance and are nearing the end of their service. It is hard to believe that those units like the hall itself are twenty-two years old! The approximate cost of this project is \$70,000.

Several years ago, our Finance Committee and Church Council established a Major Projects fund to help make these larger projects possible. Our church budget set an amount to be deposited monthly into the Major Projects fund for larger items beyond a monthly Trustees stipend for smaller projects such as the painting mentioned above. This approach has served us well. We were able to replace the roof on our entire church building, replace a couple of air conditioning units, and address several other maintenance issues because of the Major Projects Fund.


We are getting to the point where our maintenance needs are greater than the income generated by our General Fund budget. The HVAC project will leave us with less than \$15,000 in our Major Projects Fund. If an emergency maintenance issue should arise, we would not have the means to address it without borrowing money.
