We all come from someone, somewhere, and something—a people, a place, and a story. So does Jesus. In Roots: Advent and the Family Story of Jesus, we rediscover that Jesus-born naturally of a mother from a family line herself, and nurtured by a father who knew the names of his own kin many generations into the past comes from the family vine of the great King David, the son of Jesse, and from a long line of faithful men and women.
